2013 CRA – Junior Achievement Charity Regatta NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*, including US Sailing Prescriptions, except US Sailing Prescriptions to Rules 60 and 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.2 The USCG “Navigation Rules: International Inland”, the Class Rules of PHRF-SD, the Entry Form, Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions and any amendments hereto will apply, except PHRF MIR rule is not in effect for this event.
- 1.3 This is a PHRF Category 4 event. PHRF “RLC” ratings will be used to score all races. PHRF non-spinnaker offsets will not be used for scoring.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all members of organizations affiliated with US Sailing.
- 2.2 To be eligible, yachts must have a current Rating Certificate from PHRF San Diego or PHRF Southern California. Multi-hull yachts are exempted from this requirement. Yachts that race with their PHRF Southern California Certificate will not have this race scored for the annual PHRF San Diego Championship Series.
- 2.3 All eligible boats must enter on-line at www.cortezracing.com, no later than **5:00pm** on Friday, June 7, 2013.
- 2.4 Late entries will only be accepted from CRA members. Late entrants may not check in by radio, but must provide to the R/C, in writing, the owner’s name, DOB and zip code, boat name and type, sail number, class, and RLC rating, with payment, to complete their entry.

3 FEES

- 3.1 \$75.00 Skipper Registration Fee is credited to fundraising.
- 3.2 Rating Adjustment Fundraiser: Each boat will receive a 1 second per mile rating adjustment for each \$100 raised for Junior Achievement. No limit on the adjustment! The more money raised, the higher the rating. Skipper and crew add together to meet team goal of \$1,000. Deadline for fundraising to count towards rating adjustments is Friday, June 7th, 5:00pm.

- 3.3 Participants are encouraged to help raise funds for Junior Achievement by sending a donation link via e-mail to family and friends. Send your link to all of your contacts and then ask your crew to do the same. Family, friends and business colleagues are all possible contributors. You do no more than send them the link! All contributions are done on-line with little direct fundraising or money handling. Donations are tax deductible. For every \$1,000 you raise it will give 25 more San Diego students the opportunity to learn financial literacy, work readiness, and entrepreneurship. JA Programs empower students to make a connection between what they learn in school and how it can be applied to the real world.

4 CLASSES, CLASS PENNANTS, AND PENNANT COLOR

- 4.1 The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts when checking in, while racing, and when finishing.
- 4.2 CRA classes shall utilize PHRF class breaks as follows:

Class 1	Spinnaker	Random Leg Rating of +6 and below	#1
Class 2A	Sprit Boats	Random Leg Rating of +57 and below	#2
Class 2B	Sprit Boats	Random Leg Rating of +60 and above	#2
Class 3	Spinnaker	Random Leg Rating of +9 through +84, or Random Leg Rating of +87 through +135 with LOA 42 feet or greater	#3
Class 4	Spinnaker	Random Leg Rating of +87 through +135 with LOA less than 42 feet	#4
Class 5	Spinnaker	Random Leg Rating of +138 and above	#5
Class 6	Non-Spin	Random Leg Rating of +174 and below	#6
Class 7	Non-Spin	Random Leg Rating of +177 and above	#7
Class 8	Multi-Hulls	All ratings	#8

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Two races are scheduled.
- 5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is **11:55am**. The warning signal for the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the first race.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions and course chart will be available no later than **5pm, June 7, 2013**, at www.cortezracing.com.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The starting area is in the vicinity of the ½ mile marker mid-Harbor Island.
- 7.2 The racing area covers the general locale known as San Diego Bay. For navigation, refer to NOAA Chart #18773, San Diego Bay.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 For all classes, the first two sentences of *Rule 44.1* are changed to: *'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing or rule 31. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'*
- 8.2 **Appendix T2 Penalties Taken After a Race** will apply.
- 8.3 **Appendix T5 Protest Arbitration** will apply.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores. No score will be excluded.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile devices.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Race results will be announced at the after race meeting at ~~The Red Sails Inn, and~~ published on the CRA web site.
- 11.2 Regatta prizes will be awarded using the listed procedure: one prize in each class of 4 yachts, two for 5-7 yachts, three for 8 or more, based on the number of finishers in the class.
- 11.3 Special JA Charity Regatta prizes will also be awarded according to the donation-adjusted ratings.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
